India-Germany Collaboration in the AI sector

On 4th December 2020, the Consulate General of India in Frankfurt organized a Webinar on the topic: "India-Germany Collaboration in the AI sector". The Webinar was organized in cooperation with ASSOCHAM and NRW.GLOBAL Business.

The webinar saw an exchange of experiences and ideas between leaders from the Indian & German government and private sector. Speakers included representatives from NITI Aayog, MeitY, ASSOCHAM, the Government of Gujarat, and Telangana from India and NRW.GLOBAL Business, Thyssen Krupp Elevators, and Digital Innovation Hub from Germany.

The panelists highlighted several important areas underlining the scope for the application of AI in various sectors covering agriculture, cyber-security, health care, manufacturing, mobility services, and disaster management.

Several useful and concrete suggestions were presented by speakers from both Indian and German side on possible areas of cooperation. The discussion extended to collaboration between academia on R&D in the field of Artificial Intelligence. Subjects of Intelligent Agriculture, Digital Farming and AI applications in security infrastructure as also natural calamities were discussed.

The event concluded with a Q&A session in which the panel speakers answered questions regarding possible collaborations between India and Germany in the field of AI.
